REPAIR KIT INSTRUCTIONS

PATCH MIX

- 1. In one of the empty clear containers, fill up about ¼ of the cup with the colored grout mix.
- 2. Pour in the Admixture and mix. Start slow and add more Admix as needed until you get a creamy consistency.
- 3. Using one of the wooden depressor's (or a square razor blade/slim putty knife), apply the mix to your repair area and shape the mix application as best as possible so there isn't a large amount of excess.
- 4. If it's a large chip repair, you may need to fill partially, let dry for a bit, and then add another layer on top.
- 5. Let the repair dry overnight if possible. On a small chip repair, the grout mix would likely be dry in a couple hours.
- 6. Once the fill is dry (the color will lighten and feel solid to touch) you can sand with 150-220 grit sandpaper to shape and smooth out the repair.

SEALER

- 1. For polished finishes, start with the Epoxy. If acid wash/boardform finish, skip to sealer. The epoxy is mixed 2 parts RESIN to 1 part HARDENER in one of the empty clear containers. Mix well.
- 2. Use a microfiber towel to dab some epoxy onto the fill spot.
- 3. Once concrete color matches the surrounding concrete, wipe off excess epoxy. This could be as soon as immediately to several minutes.
- 4. Let the epoxy dry, preferably overnight. On small repairs, the epoxy will likely dry in a couple of hours.
- 5. Once dry (no tackiness to touch), you can apply the final sealer, which is labeled as the sealer container.
- 6. Similarly, with a microfiber towel, lightly apply some sealer to the fill spot. 2 coats would be recommended, a couple hours in between coats.
